Be part of a small nonprofit arts organization in a rural community!

SYT Choreographer will work directly with SYT Director, Music Director & Artistic Director to lead our production team and support our kids.

Duties:

- Cast the show in conjunction with the director, music director and artistic director
- Design the dance numbers and other stage movements to coincide with the artistic vision of the production and the dance skill of the kids; should include a balance of supporting where the kids are, and inspiring them to learn and grow as performers
- Teach the cast the dance numbers and stage movements
- Attend camp daily and be part of full range of schedule
- Attend all production meetings
- Support a strong, collaborative team with the director, music director and artistic director in order to support the artistic vision of the production

- Self-motivated and independent with effective organization and communications skills
- Friendly, outgoing professional demeanor combined with ability to maintain confidentiality
